## CGI Learning Center Annual Report 2013

From June 2012 to May 2013 CGI Learning Center acquired 92 new books ordered by the faculty, received 25 new theses, and 6,664 titles as gift from public and private institutions, which are available to search from the library's online catalog. 14 online reference databases including CGI subscribed "Britannica Online" were accessed with 31,745 transactions. Visitors to the library, 2,591 visits in person and 1,700 visits via CGI Learning Center Fanpage. 626 books were checked out and 1,106 documents were requested and delivered. Seminars on database searching and on VPN access to CGI network were organized, to promote the use of knowledge resources. And, along with CGI Learning Center Bulletin, other channels of communications are provided: enewsletters, posters, brochures, and exhibitions to encourage CGI community to keep update and to be alert of new knowledge in print and digital forms.
