CGI Learning Center has total 6,899 publications in 2014, and provides 14 reference databases.



Online reference databases were accessed 28,447 times, 2,109 library visitors, 1,748 library Fan Page visitors, and 599 times library lending, and 1,436 document delivery.

User services included library orientation, 3 seminars on reference databases, workshop on VPN access. Exhibitions, Book and reading promotion were organized all year both on site and online from CGI Learning Center Web Page.
