Creating Academic Publications in the Digital Age: Copyright



April 23, 2019 CGI Learning Center “Open Knowledge sharing on copyright” organized a lecture, inviting Dr.Titima Thammabumrung from NSTDA to share her knowledge and experience to researchers and students. Dr.Titima covered important topics: What copyright means and fair use for creating academic publications in terms of Thai and international law. Guidelines on how to make use of digital and printed information were presented.



And, several “Open Educational Resources-OER” that are available on Internet were introduced. The term “OER” was first coined at UNESCO’s 2002 Forum on Open Courseware, and designates teaching, learning and research materials in any medium, digital or otherwise, that reside in the public domain or have been released under an open license that permits no-cost access, use, adaptation and redistribution by others with no or limited restrictions. Open licensing is built within the existing framework of intellectual property rights as defined by relevant international conventions and respects the authorship of the work.

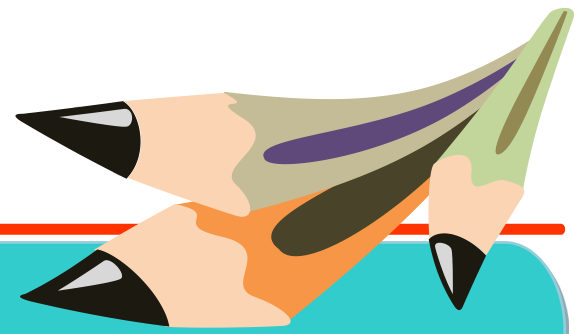

User satisfaction survey on services and reference databases in the Fiscal Year 2019, surveying from June 10 to 30, 2019.

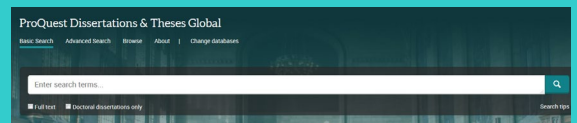
54 responded by most of Ph.D. students from ABS Program, Male 19 and Female 35:

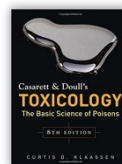
And, you will find the tips to better searching from using Boolean operators "And" "Not" "OR" "NEAR/#" "PRE/#" to broaden and narrow your search.
