🌸 CGI published in international journals

Since 2007, CGI publications have been accepted to publish in international journals with Impact Factor higher than 2. The journals covered the Journal of Antimicrobial Chemotherapy, Phytochemistry, Tetrahedron, European Journal of Organic Chemistry, International Journal of Hygiene and Environmental Health, Journal of Antimicrobial Chemotherapy, Chemistry- A European Journal, Infection and Immunity, Proteomics, Food Chemistry.

CGI research programs were conducted in cooperation with CRI - Chulabhorn Research Institute. Publications were searched in the following years and showed only articles in journals with Impact Factor higher than 2, and summarized as follows:

- 2011 showed 17 articles and cited 9 times.
- 2010 showed 28 articles and cited 54 times.
- 2009 showed 21 articles and cited 30 times.
- 2008 showed 15 articles and cited 40 times.
- 2007 showed 14 articles and cited 41 times.
