on July 24, 2014.*





## SURVEY RESULT:


*2014 Internet survey on CGI Learning Center's user satisfaction from using services and reference databases found that 56% of the population responded. And, reference databases which were used most frequently and used occasionally were 8 databases : SpringerLink – Journal, American Chemical Society Journal (ACS), ISI Web of Knowledge, EBSCO Discovery Service, ABI/INFORM Complete, H.W. Wilson 12 subjects, Britannica Online Encyclopedia, and ProQuest Dissertations & Theses. And most respondents were Chemical Biology students and most students accessed the services from off-and on campus by Internet, desktops and laptops, and still popular is of course the personal visits to the library.*
