The Ph.D. Qualifying Examination Committee is tasked with the following responsibilities:

- 1. Setting the dates and times for administering examinations for both fundamental and specialized subjects
- 2. Issuing an announcement on the Ph.D. Qualifying Examination
- 3. Determining the criteria for the Ph.D. Qualifying Examination
- 4. The chairperson of the Ph.D. Qualifying Examination Committee will be responsible in arranging the Committee discussion on relevant issues, namely
  - 4.1 Assigning the fundamental and specialized subjects to be evaluated in the exam
  - 4.2 Designating a committee member who will be responsible for coordinating with the course coordinators to collect and compile exam questions

- 4.3 Designating a committee member who will distribute the exam papers to the responsible faculty members for grading, and compile the results
- 5. Finalizing the results of the Ph.D. Qualifying Examination in each subject within two weeks after the completion of the examination
- 6. Making an announcement of students who have passed the Ph.D. Qualifying Examination
- 7. Considering an arrangement for a re-examination for students who have not met the passing criteria
